- Be treated with dignity
- Have privacy
- Humane treatment and care
- Speak with an attorney or advocate
- Vote
- Send and receive unopened mail
- Have visitors
- Worship
- Go outside
- Use the telephone
- Keep and spend a reasonable amount of money
- Be free from mental and physical abuse, neglect, and exploitation
