Disability Rights NC (DRNC) protects your rights.

YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO:

- Have privacy
- Use the phone
- Send and receive mail
- Eat healthy foods
- Have visitors
- Receive an education
- Have and spend a reasonable amount of money

- Go outside
- Have your own storage space
- Have your own clothes and belongings
- Participate in worship
- Be treated with dignity and respect
- Be free from harm, abuse, and unnecessary restraint and seclusion
- Get treatment and services

Some of your rights can be restricted. When your rights are restricted, your parent or guardian must be notified.
